10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1320.1 of Title 59, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Pursuant to Section 1320 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, a
15 bondsman is authorized to write bonds on up to ten (10) defendants
16 per year January 1 through December 31 in each county outside his or
17 her resident county. For purposes of determining the ten-defendant
18 bond limit pursuant to Section 1320 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
19 Statutes, the bondsman shall consider each date a bond or bonds are
20 written on a single individual as being one of the ten-defendant
21 limit notwithstanding any previous bonds which have been written on
22 that same individual. The ten-defendant limit does not apply in
23 counties without a registered bondsman in such county.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2013.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
