2	To enact R.S. 33:447.11, relative to mayor's courts; to provide for additional court costs for
3	violations of municipal ordinances and traffic violations in the mayor's courts in the
4	municipalities of DeQuincy, Iowa, Vinton, and Westlake; to provide for the allocation of
5	additional funds; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 33:447.11 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§447.11. Mayor's court; certain municipalities; additional court costs
9	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the mayors of the
10	municipalities of DeQuincy, Iowa, Vinton, and Westlake may impose additional court costs
11	not to exceed twenty dollars for each offense, as defined by ordinance, on any defendant
12	convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance or traffic violation, provided that fifty
13	percent of any additional court cost collected pursuant to this Section shall be remitted to
14	the Fourteenth Judicial District's Indigent Defender Fund.
15	Section 2. R.S. 33:447.11 as enacted by this Act shall be null and void on August 1, 2016.
16	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed
17	by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the
18	governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the
19	governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day
20	following such approval.
