STATE

- There is currently no state-wide shelter in place order in effect as of 3/26

LOCAL JURISDICTIONS

- City of Charleston: Shelter in Place for 14 days, effective March 26, 2020

COURTS

- State-wide civil/criminal trials and all in-person matters/motions/hearings other than emergency hearings are cancelled through May 1, 2020

- Upon the request of a required attendee at mediation, attendance by video conference is permitted. Effective 03/19/20

- SC State Appellate Courts have cancelled oral arguments and hearings. Rules for service/delivery of appellate documents are modified as outlined in the Order. While order is in place, no fee for extensions of time. All due dates on and after this date (3/20/20) are extended 20 days, except notice to file appeal. There will be forgiveness of procedural defaults since 3/13/20. Effective 03/20/20

- United States District Court—District of South Carolina: all civil/criminal jury selections, jury trials, in-person hearings, and roster meetings are continued through May 8, 2020. All civil court deadlines are extended by 21 days from the current deadline; statutes of limitations are not tolled. The Court’s consideration of motions that can be resolved without court appearance is not affected. Effective 03/16/20
