RE: **Public Posting of "Stay at Home"
Orders**

To follow up from our email last evening, we have heard from agents in Dallas that law enforcement had no issues with the bail industry continuing to operate. They agreed that bail falls within the "Essential Services" exemption. However, they requested that the agents post a copy of the "Stay at Home" Order on their office door. This would notify passing law enforcement that the office was aware of the order and believed it was in compliance as an "Essential Business."

That being the case in Dallas, we recommend that if your county has issued a "Stay at Home" Order, that you print out a copy of the order and display it in your office. Additionally, if you still want a copy of the letter emailed to you, we are more than happy to review your county's specific order, if we have not already, and decide whether a letter is appropriate.
