RE: **Broward and Dade County Administrative Orders Regarding Forfeitures**

Please click on the links below to see two recent Emergency Administrative Orders out of both Broward and Dade Counties regarding bond forfeitures.

Broward County – 17th Judicial Circuit

According to Administrative Order AOSC20-23 (<http://www.17th.flcourts.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/04/2020-32-Temp.pdf>), issued by Chief Justice Charles Canady on April 6, 2020, **payment of bonds forfeited are extended until the close of business on Friday May 29th, 2020.**

(2) Bond Forfeitures. All time limits prescribed by statute or rule of court pertaining to the forfeiture of bonds and/or payment of bonds forfeited are extended until the close of business on Friday, May 29, 2020.

We recommend you review the entire order in full and contact the court directly with any questions.

Dade County – 11th Judicial Circuit

According to Administrative Order 20-08 (<https://www.jud11.flcourts.org/Render?fileid=%7bCCA2361D-86B1-4BCB-BDB5-62816EFCB42B%7d>), issued by Chief Judge Bertila Soto on April 7th, 2020, time limits applicable to bond forfeitures are suspended until the close of business on Monday, June 1, 2020.

*2. All time limits set by judicial order and/or authorized by rule and statute applicable to civil (inclusive of circuit and county), family, domestic violence, dependency, probate, small claims, traffic, **bond forfeiture**, and appellate proceedings **are further suspended until the close of business on Monday, June 1, 2020.***
